## BELONGING TO A COMMUNITY



**Strategy:** Changing the Background in Online Platforms

**Audience:** Kindergarten to Grade 12

### What:

- To teach students to change their backgrounds during online classroom meetings

### How:

- Teach students how to change or alter their backgrounds in online platforms
- Blur background feature can help to decrease distractions, reduce visual overload, as well add privacy
- Apply alternative picture backgrounds with preset images or one of your own choosing (i.e., tropical scene, favourite pet, etc.)
- Be creative, ask students to change their backgrounds to different themes (i.e., Please change your background to your dream vacation spot.)

### Inclusive Practices to Consider:

- Collaborate with students regarding voice and choice when requesting video cameras be on during remote sessions (i.e., students can have their cameras on during 1:1 session with the teacher or for short intervals of time versus the entire session)
